## MiMi en Provence Grande Réserve Rosé

From Provence, France. Made from Grenache, Cinsault, and Syrah. Aromas of red berry and white peach. Perfectly balanced with a crisp and long finish.

## Vergers du Soleil Rosé

From Provence, France. Highly aromatic, with delicate notes of raspberry, peach, and white blossoms. Lovely length and a refreshing finish.

## Châteauvieux Rosé D'Anjou

From the Loire Valley region in France. Aromas of gooseberry and strawberry on the nose lead into bursting red berry fruit on the palate. The lively acidity makes this refreshing and easy to drink.

## Famiglie Rosé IGT

From Italy. Juicy aromas of strawberries, plums, and cranberries along with scents of roses and gardenias. Dry, medium-bodied, and refreshing.

## Ballard Road Pinot Noir Rosé

From Oregon. Made from Pinot Noir grapes. Floral strawberry and watermelon aromas with crisp, lively flavors.

## Fox Run Rosé

From Seneca Lake, NY. A blend of Pinot Noir and Lemberger. An exuberant fruit-forward nose, with playful red berry flavors and a crisp, refreshing finish.
